Primary Purpose and Scope of the Job:

In consultation with the LiveWire Aquatics Manager, support, plan, deliver and evaluate the Aquatics Programme as part of a team of teachers working across Warrington to help residents work through Swim England's Learn to Swim Awards Programme.

WORKING RELATIONSHIPS

Swim Teachers will work closely with and support pupils, Aquatics Programme Management, Leisure Centre staff & Key Stakeholders.

Relationships with both internal and external customers will be crucial to ensure the delivery of a quality service and to enhance the reputation of the organisation as well as its corporate and business performance.

KEY TASKS AND ACCOUNTABILITIES

- 1. To support Level 2 Swim Teachers to carry out any administration work and procedures in connection with the Learn to Swim programme as directed by the Aquatics Manager, including accurate recording of attendance.
- Support with delivery of lessons within the Learn to Swim Programme, assisting
 the lead swimming teacher where needed in the water, whether supporting children
 with additional needs, to build confidence of nervous swimmers or assisting with
 behaviour management.
- 3. Support the lead swimming teacher to assess children against the standards set within the Swim England Learn to Swim Framework.
- 4. Ensure all equipment necessary for your lesson is prepared prior to the start of the lesson in order for the lesson to commence at the appointed time. Ensure all equipment is put away tidily at the conclusion of the lessons.

- 6. To attend any ongoing training or CPD which are appropriate to your position as directed by the Aquatics Manager.
- 7. To hold an up to date pool safety qualification, such as the RLSS National Rescue Award for Swimming Teachers and Coaches (NRASTC), and keep this qualification up to date by attending regular training and renewals when required.
- 8. To wear staff uniform as issued at all times when on duty
- 9. Customer care to ensure customer satisfaction at all times by ensuring that the lessons are conducted in a friendly and professional manner
- 10. To undertake any other duties as directed by the Learn to Swim Manager which contribute to the general purpose and objectives of LiveWire Warrington.
