

Learn to Swim

Drop off and Pick up Processes



Bewsey and Dallam Community Hub

Due to the limited space on poolside, children will be asked to wait by the entrance to the poolside.

- Children are to wait on the left hand side by the main pool door until called by the swimming instructor.
- Teachers aren't responsible for your child until their lesson starts
- Upon leaving the pool, children must be picked up from the poolside

Broomfields Leisure Centre

- Children are to enter poolside via the changing rooms no more than 5 minutes before a lesson begins
- Children will be asked to sit on the benches to wait for their lessons:
 - o If over 8 years old they can sit unaccompanied
 - o If under 8 years old, they must be accompanied by an adult until the teacher has called them to their lesson – no outdoor shoes are to be worn on poolside (flip flops allowed)
 - o Teachers aren't responsible for your child until their lesson starts
- Upon leaving the pool, children must be picked up from the changing rooms entry point – parents do not need to enter poolside. Swimmers over the age of 8 can leave poolside unaccompanied.

Great Sankey Neighbourhood Hub

To avoid overcrowding there is a designated drop and pick up point in place around poolside for lessons.

Drop off point – group changing area door (accessible via main changing village)

Pick up point – entrance to poolside via changing village double doors

- Children are to wait for their lesson in the following locations no more than 5 minutes before the lesson:
 - o Children over the age of 8 are permitted to sit on allocated benches (under teacher's name signs) on poolside without supervision.
 - o Children under the age of 8 must wait by the group change entrance door with a parent/guardian before a lesson. Swimmers will be collected by their swim teacher and brought back following their session to the double door entrance of the changing village.
- Swimmers will be collected by their swim teacher and brought back following their session to the double doors. Swimmers under the age of 8 must be collected by a responsible adult.
- If a child is over 8 years old they can wait for their lesson unaccompanied by an adult and can enter the changing rooms on their own following their lesson. Teachers aren't responsible for your child until their lesson starts.
- Parents are asked to watch from the viewing gallery and not to stay on poolside. You will be asked to politely move to the gallery if on poolside without permission from the Aquatics Manager.

Orford Jubilee Neighbourhood Hub

- Children will be asked to follow the below poolside process for lessons, as per the below:
 - o Children over the age of 8 are permitted to sit on allocated benches (under teacher's name signs) on poolside without supervision.
 - o Children under the age of 8 must wait in the group change corridor alongside the right hand side with a parent/guardian before a lesson. Swimmers will be collected by their swim teacher and returned following their session to the same corridor.
- Children who are changing in the female changing room can walk around to the group change corridor by poolside to wait for their class.
- Please note that teachers are not responsible for your child until their lesson starts.
- Once your child has begun their lesson, parents can watch from the gallery. Only parents with permission to stay on poolside from the Aquatics Manager will be permitted to sit on poolside. If you do not have prior permission, you will be politely asked to move to the gallery.
- Parents are not permitted to enter the pool hall unless shoe coverings or are wearing flip flops/barefoot.

Woolston Neighbourhood Hub

- Children under the age of 8 must be dropped off (no more than 5 minutes prior to a lesson) and collected by parents from the shower entrance to the poolside.
- Children over the age of 8 can sit in the designated place for their lesson (no more than 5 minutes prior to a lesson) which are signposted in the pool hall.
- Teachers aren't responsible for your child until their lesson starts.
- Parents can watch lessons from the gallery and are not permitted to be on poolside unless permission has been granted by the Aquatics Manager.
- Parents are not permitted to enter the pool hall unless shoe coverings are used.
